- We will have no more than a 6 students to 1 pharmacist ratio in the legislator offices at a time
  - I highly recommend that you plan to meet with your group minimally 20 minutes before going to speak to the legislator to delegate who is saying what
  - Plan to only have 5-10 minutes to speak as the legislators are busy
  - If you meet with the legislative aid instead of the legislator, treat them with the same respect and professionalism as you would with the legislator; they are the legislators' right-hand people
